 - Foundation for Tier 2 (starting age 9/10)

– 说说唱唱学汉语 – cont.

- CD-ROM homework
- Flashcards

- Teachers

- Audio CDs
- Teaching guide (first two years)

Experience

- 2002-03
 - using self-written materials (first half)
 - Golden-bridge
- 2003-04
 - Initial piloting “Chinese Made Fun”
- 2004-05
 - “Chinese Made Fun” not available
 - “Happy Chinese”
- 2005 –
 - “Chinese Made Fun”
 - Sunny Book House (investment near \$20K)

Experience – cont.

- Feedback
 - Students
 - Love to sing and act
 - Teachers
 - Sufficient materials to work with
 - Parents
 - CD-ROM helps a great deal
